Pre School Learning Journey

During October we continued with our Marvelous Me topic. We spent time learning about Harvest and particularly enjoyed finding out about how combine harvesters work and what they do during Harvest. We also collected donations for Harvest which we took to the Salvation Army. On this walk we were also lucky enough to see the chapel in the Salvation Army as well as Shepton Market. The children were interested in what each of the stalls were selling. Our favourite part was finding

a turnip on the vegetable stall which tied in with our focus book, The Enormous Turnip. We also made soup using seasonal vegetables which we helped to peel and cut.

We also learnt about our local area. We looked at photos of landmarks in Shepton Mallet

as Collett Park, The Cenotaph, Tesco retail park and the Market Cross. We also looked at a simple map of the town and discovered where nursery was on the map, as well some of the other landmarks. It was great to see the children recognise some of these things as well as seeing some of them on our walks.

We finished the term by focusing on Halloween. Room on the Broom was our focus book and the children became familiar with the story, using the story spoons to show their knowledge and understanding. On the mark making table we created our own witches hats using gems and

collage and the children also made broomsticks using natural materials. The Halloween dressing up was popular, as well as potion mixing using a variety of different medians such as water, shaving foam and gloop.





Nursery Learning Journey

Throughout October we continued to follow our curriculum plan of marvellous me which included covering the topics of Autumn, Harvest and Halloween.

During our Autumn topic, we were able to take a walk to the nearby field where we collected a selection of conkers, leaves and sticks to incorporate into our activities. The children were able to use the leaves we collected on our walk to create their own Autumnal trees which we displayed in the room on our art board.

Our Harvest topic became a firm favourite amongst the children within the Nursery room as they had the opportunity to take a trip to the Salvation Army to drop off our donations as well as popping to the Friday Market in town. The children explored plenty of activities around farming, where we used a range of sensory experiences to enhance their place. For example using rice as grass, Weetabix for hay and Cocoa powder mixed with water for mud. Throughout this topic, the song 'Big Red Combine Harvester' was enjoyed by all and was often picked as our circle time song. We ended up offering the children the opportunity to choose the colour of their combine harvester every morning.

We completed the term by discovering and investigating all things Halloween. The children were provided with the opportunity to use natural resources such as sticks as paint brushes to decorate their own pumpkin pictures. We made and decorated Halloween themed biscuits using icing and sprinkles shaped as ghosts, bats and pumpkins. It was lovely to see so many children dressed up on Halloween! We explored tuff trays full of coloured rice, cut open pumpkins to see what was inside and even decorated a Spooky House using pencil crayons.
